1989 - poultry farm in the Semipalatinsk region, Priirtyshskoye village.
1990 - work in an equestrian acrobatic troupe at the Soviet State Circus, Moscow.
1992– after the collapse of the USSR, returned to Kazakhstan and began working as part of an equestrian acrobatic troupe at the Kazakh State Circus under the leadership of Kunguzhinov Batyrbek
1993 to 2000, as part of the Nomad equestrian acrobatic troupe of the Kazakh State Circus, represented the circus art of Kazakhstan in Italy, China, France, Ukraine and Russia.
In 2000 founded the Nomad Stunts Group

2. Teaching disciplines:

Stage movement I-II, Stage fight.

3. Creative, research and innovative activities:

In 1993, at the International Festival of Circus Arts in China, won the Silver Lion award (second place).
In 2001, at the International Festival of Equestrian Acrobatics in China, was awarded the "Bronze Lion" (third place) and awarded the People's Choice Award.
In 2007, won the Golden Bear at the International Festival of Circus Arts in Russia (first place).
In 2013, the International Academy of Martial Arts (USA) recognized Zhaidarbek Kunguzhinov as the winner in the nomination "For the popularization of sports in the cinema"; this award is also called the "Sports Oscar".
In 2017, Zhaidarbek Kunguzhinov was nominated for the Taurus World Stunt Academy Award (best action in a foreign film - Viking, directed by Andrey Kravchuk, Russia).
Since 2017, the Nomad Stunts stunt group has been an official partner of the Red Crescent Society of Kazakhstan and supports socially oriented initiatives, and, in addition, conducts hippotherapy sessions for adults and children with special needs on a charitable basis.

In 2018, Zhaidarbek Kunguzhinov and Nomad Stunts team members entered the Kazakhstan KINES book of records; Zhaidarbek Kunguzhinov also became the owner of the state award - the Order of Kurmet.

In 2020, won the Taurus World Stunt Academy Award in Los Angeles, USA.
