

1. FIELD OF APPLICATION

1.1. This Regulation on the Development and Implementation of joint and double-degree educational programs (hereinafter referred to as the Regulation) defines the procedure for the development, implementation, management and quality assurance of joint and double-degree educational programs at the Temirbek Zhurgenov Kazakh National Academy of Arts of the Ministry of Education and Science of the Republic of Kazakhstan (hereinafter referred to as the Academy).

1.2. These Regulations apply to the structural divisions of the Academy involved in the development, implementation, maintenance, monitoring and quality assurance of joint and double-degree educational programs.

1.3. This Regulation is an internal regulatory document of the Academy and is applied in order to implement international cooperation, academic mobility, internationalization of education and improve the quality of training.


1.4. Joint educational programs are implemented by the Academy jointly with organizations of higher and (or) postgraduate education of the Republic of Kazakhstan and/or foreign organizations of higher education on the basis of concluded agreements and in accordance with the legislation of the Republic of Kazakhstan, internal documents of the Academy and agreements between partner universities.

1.5. This Regulation regulates:

- the development and implementation of joint educational programs;
- development and implementation of double-degree educational programs;
- organization of academic mobility of students within the framework of joint educational programs;
- the procedure for the recognition of learning outcomes and the transfer of academic credits;
- Issues of quality assurance of joint and double-degree educational programs.

1.6. The implementation of joint and double-degree educational programs is based on the principles of:

- academic freedom;
- Partnership and mutual recognition;

- Comparability of learning outcomes;
- Transparency of the educational process;
- Ensuring the quality of education;
- Compliance with the requirements of the national education systems of the partner countries.

4. BASIC CONCEPTS AND DEFINITIONS

4.1. The following basic concepts and definitions are used in the Regulation:

- 1) Joint Educational Program (JEP) – an educational program developed and implemented by the Academy in collaboration with one or more OHPE-partners on the basis of an agreement providing for joint participation in the development and implementation of the educational program, recognition of learning outcomes, and the issuance of a single educational credential to the graduate.
- 2) Double Degree Program (DDP) – a joint educational program that provides for the issuance of educational documents by each of the participating parties to the graduate.
- 3) Joint implementation of an educational program – the organization of the educational process by the Academy and OHPE-partners based on agreed conditions of study, distribution of the academic workload, learning outcomes, and academic recognition procedures.
- 4) Academic recognition – the recognition of learning outcomes achieved by a student at OHPE-partners for the purpose of their transfer and crediting toward the completion of an educational program.
- 5) OHPE-partners – higher and/or postgraduate education institutions of the Republic of Kazakhstan or foreign higher education institutions participating in the development and/or implementation of JEP and DDP on the basis of a concluded agreement.
- 6) Joint final assessment – a form of final assessment conducted with the participation of representatives of the Academy and OHPE-partners.
- 7) ECTS – a European system for the accumulation and transfer of credits, designed to facilitate student mobility. It is based on the estimation of the workload required to achieve the learning outcomes of an educational program (EP). The system enhances the transparency of higher education systems and promotes student mobility across Europe through the accumulation and transfer of credits.

5. ORGANIZATION OF IMPLEMENTATION OF JEP AND DDP

5.1. JEP and DDP are implemented by the Academy jointly with OHPE-partners on the basis of concluded agreements in accordance with the legislation of the

Republic of Kazakhstan and the internal regulatory documents of the Academy and OHPE-partners.

5.2. JEP and DDP are developed and implemented within educational programs of the respective levels of personnel training, ensuring the comparability of learning outcomes and academic requirements of OHPE-partners.

5.3. The implementation of JEP and DDP is carried out on the basis of:

- agreed educational programs and curricula;
- mutual recognition of learning outcomes;
- academic mobility of students and/or faculty members;
- joint participation of OHPE-partners in the organization of the educational process and quality assurance in education.

5.4. The language of instruction in JEP and DDP is determined by agreement between OHPE-partners.

5.5. JEP and DDP are developed, approved, and implemented in accordance with the procedure established by the legislation of the Republic of Kazakhstan and the internal regulatory documents of OHPE-partners.

5.6. Any amendments to JEP and DDP are made upon agreement between OHPE-partners.

5.7. The implementation of JEP and DDP shall ensure conditions for the academic recognition of learning outcomes, credit transfer, and compliance with the requirements of the quality assurance systems of OHPE-partners.

6. DEVELOPMENT AND IMPLEMENTATION OF JEP AND DDP

6.1. The basis for the development and implementation of JEP and DDP is a cooperation agreement concluded between the Academy and the OHPE-partner.


6.2. The agreement on the implementation of JEP and DDP defines:

- conditions for the implementation of the educational program;
- distribution of responsibilities between OHPE-partners;
- procedures for organizing the educational process;
- conditions for academic recognition of learning outcomes;
- procedures for issuing educational credentials;
- funding arrangements and other conditions for program implementation.

6.3. The development of JEP and DDP is carried out by the graduating department jointly with the OHPE-partner and relevant structural units of the Academy.

6.4. Training under JEP and DDP is conducted, where necessary, on the basis of agreements concluded in accordance with the legislation of the Republic of Kazakhstan and the internal regulatory documents of OHPE-partners.

6.5. Enrollment and participation of students in JEP and DDP are carried out in accordance with admission rules, internal regulatory documents, and the terms of the agreement between OHPE-partners.

6.6. JEP and DDP may include academic mobility of students and/or faculty members in accordance with the terms of the agreement between OHPE-partners.

6.7. In the implementation of JEP and DDP, comparability of learning outcomes, academic recognition, and credit transfer of academic credits earned by students at the OHPE-partner are ensured.

6.8. The organization of the educational process, including the procedures for studying disciplines, undertaking internships, conducting final assessment, and issuing educational credentials, is determined by the agreement between OHPE-partners and the internal regulatory documents of OHPE-partners.

6.9. An individual study plan of a student is developed taking into account the educational programs of OHPE-partners and defines the list of courses, workload, distribution of studies, and the procedure for credit transfer.

6.10. The structure and duration of studies within JEP and DDP are determined by the agreement between OHPE-partners, taking into account the requirements of the State Compulsory Standards of Higher and Postgraduate Education (SCSES) of the Republic of Kazakhstan.

6.11. Learning outcomes achieved by a student at an OHPE-partner are confirmed by a transcript or other academic document containing information on courses (modules), academic credits, and learning outcomes, and are subject to academic recognition and credit transfer in the established manner.

6.12. The final assessment of students under JEP and DDP is conducted in accordance with the procedure defined by the agreement between OHPE-partners and the internal regulatory documents of OHPE-partners.

6.13. Upon completion of studies and fulfillment of JEP and DDP requirements, educational credentials are issued to graduates in accordance with the conditions of the educational program implementation, the agreement between OHPE-partners, and the legislation of the countries of the OHPE-partners.


7. MANAGEMENT AND QUALITY ASSURANCE OF JEP AND DDP

7.1. The implementation of JEP and DDP at the Academy is carried out in accordance with the legislation of the Republic of Kazakhstan, the internal regulatory documents of the Academy, and agreements with OHPE-partners.

7.2. Structural units of the Academy involved in the implementation of JEP and DDP provide organizational, academic-methodological, and informational support for the educational process.

7.3. Quality assurance of JEP and DDP implementation is carried out by the Academy jointly with OHPE-partners in accordance with their internal quality assurance systems in education.

7.4. Monitoring of the implementation of JEP and DDP is carried out by the Academy jointly with OHPE-partners, coordinated by the structural unit

responsible for overseeing JEP and DDP implementation, and includes the assessment of learning outcomes, students' academic performance, the effectiveness of cooperation between the parties, as well as the analysis of students' satisfaction with the quality of the educational program implementation.

7.5. The Academy ensures the dissemination of information to students, faculty members, OHPE-partners, and other stakeholders on the objectives, content, implementation features, monitoring results, and areas for improvement of JEP and DDP through official information resources, internal communication channels, and other forms of interaction at least once per academic year.

7.6. In the event of termination of JEP and DDP implementation, the Academy jointly with the OHPE-partner ensures the protection of students' rights to complete their studies or transfer to other educational programs.

8. FINANCING OF JEP AND DDP

8.1. The funding of JEP and DDP is carried out in accordance with the legislation of the Republic of Kazakhstan, agreements between OHPE-partners, and the internal regulatory documents of the Academy.

8.2. Funding of JEP and DDP may be provided from:

budgetary and extra-budgetary funds;

funds of OHPE-partners;

grants, foundations, and other sources not prohibited by the legislation of the Republic of Kazakhstan;

students' own funds.


8.3. Expenses related to the implementation of JEP and DDP, including academic mobility of students and faculty members, may be financed by the Academy in accordance with the agreement between OHPE-partners and the internal regulatory documents of the Academy.

8.4. Expenses for airfare and accommodation of students within the framework of JEP and DDP implementation may be covered by the Academy in cases and under conditions stipulated by the agreement and/or contract. Expenses for meals, transportation, study materials, registration fees, and medical insurance are borne by students themselves, unless otherwise provided by the agreement between OHPE-partners.

8.5. When implementing JEP and DDP, an estimated budget may be prepared if necessary in accordance with the terms of the agreement between OHPE-partners.

8.6. The funding conditions of JEP and DDP are determined taking into account the specific features of the educational program implementation and the terms of the agreement between OHPE-partners.

- 11.2. The storage of this Regulation shall be carried out in accordance with the established procedure and the internal regulatory documents of the Academy.
